Minutes:

- Maranda provided an overview of where we are at this point in the project, providing information to the audience members joining for the first time and refreshing what we've covered for the steering committee members over the past 6 months.
- Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) requires action with the dam going forward. There are also other federal regulatory requirements- Endangered Species Act- a requirement for the fish passage for Atlantic Salmon to move up and downstream has to be effective.
- Fish passage is measured by the efficiency of the number of fish safely and timely moving past the dam.

<u>Jack Clukey:</u> We want a sustainable long-term solution to meet the community's needs.

<u>Sandy Perkins:</u> How does this fit into the vision for the town? Is there a vision? It has to fit into what the community wants to be.

<u>Denise</u>: I'd like to learn about examples and what happened to local infrastructure after and houses. What are the negatives? What might happen? Also expressed concern about the decision timeline.
